










'PERSEUS AND ANDROMEDA'


'PERSEUS, SLAYER OF MONSTERS'


'THE WANDERING RASCAL'

ABOUT ARTISTS' BOOKS

There is no set and universally definition, which is a good thing as it leaves the artist more room for freedom. If such definition existed, it would create barriers to the discipline.


The creation of artists' books is an artistic discipline in its own right where each book is a work of art. It may follow the Codex model for a book, but its sole purpose is deflection. The book is no longer a medium but the creative act of the artist. You will find that they are as many artists' books as there are artists. There are different ways to produce them, using a traditional way or mechanical processes, which allow lower prices and makes purchases more accessible.

Obriart favours the latter for this reason. The artist's book can also become an exhibition all by itself. This can be an effective way for the artist to show her/his work to the person that buys the book. Books become portable mini-exhibition centres.

'I publish artists' books. This act is not trivial but is for me a form of resistance.'
